- Applicant *must* be a full time resident in the state of New Jersey.
- Applicant *must* be a high school senior who will be attending an accredited educational institution of higher learning.
- Applicant *must* have parental consent.
- Please submit a letter of recommendation from a guidance counselor, teacher, scout leader, worship leader, organization leader or employer.

Essay Criteria:

- Essay is to be two (2) pages, “double spaced” with 1 inch margins. (500-550 words) one copy of the essay must be submitted with the essay application and one copy of the essay is to be sent electronically to ocanjscholarship@gmail.com

The OCA-NJ Spirit of Corky Lee Scholarship Award seeks to provide a \$1,500 scholarship award to a young person embodying the spirit, and vision of the "Undisputed Unofficial Asian American Photo laureate" of his time, Corky Lee, with the hopes of inspiring the next generation to help continue this important work.

Eligibility:

Applicant must be of Asian American descent.

Applicant must be a full time resident in the state of New Jersey.

Applicant must be a high school senior who will be attending an accredited educational institution of higher learning.

Applicant must have parental consent.

Please submit a letter of recommendation from a guidance counselor, teacher, scout leader, worship leader or employer.

Written Criteria:

The written portion should include the questions, followed by your answers, "double spaced" with 1 inch margins and should not exceed 500 words. These answers will be considered more based on content than grammar, prose or craft in writing. Please note A.I. generated work will be disqualified.

Artistic Criteria:

The artistic submission **MUST** be an original piece of work: photo(s) or other media, such as film, video, artwork, poetry, song, or examples of work you have done either in activism or in artistic media that reflects Corky's work in subject matter or as a craft in itself.
